The previous artist's work will be covered with only where to connect the images apparent to the succeeding adjacent artist in an attempt to make the collective image cohesive. A total of 36 members will participate. The theme will be based on Halloween and the work as a whole will be revealed during the reception. Each exhibiting member participating can work in any 2D media and will select a prompt for their subject matter from a list prepared by the gallery committee.
